DELEGATE REPORTS ARE DUE December 31, 2018

NCSMA Officers, Committee Chairs and AAMA Delegates and Alternates **MUST** submit a written report of their

activities throughout the year for the Delegates packet. Send the report to the Speaker of the House, Stephanie Hodgkin, CMA (AAMA) in a Microsoft Word document, via email attachment to her at onegreatcma99@gmail.com, **no later than Monday, December 31, 2018**. Speaker Hodgkin will send an email verification upon receipt. If you do not receive the verification email within a week of sending your report, please follow-up with the Speaker.

Chapter Presidents are responsible for submitting the names of their chapter's delegates and alternates, including the delegate's full name, correct address, their AAMA member ID number, and the date their dues were paid, if known, to Speaker Hodgkin (onegreatcma99@gmail.com) and Vice-Speaker of the House, Vicki Rummage (cma_nana5@yahoo.com) **no later than Sunday, January 16, 2019**. Speaker Hodgkin will send an email verification upon receipt of your list of chapter delegates/alternates. If you do not receive the verification email within a week of sending your list, please follow-up with the Speaker. Chapter Presidents have been notified of the number of delegates allowed for their chapter. Each delegate's eligibility will be reviewed and if the member is unable to serve as a delegate the Chapter President will be notified via email that the next alternate will move up to become a delegate. If there are no alternates available, the Chapter President will be provided a proxy card at check-in at the Credentials Desk.

While only chapter representatives can vote in the business session, all members are invited and encouraged to attend this important meeting.
